## **Welcome to Bridge Learning Campus**

I am delighted that your child has been offered a place at Bridge Learning Campus for September 2024. Our school community continues to grow, more students will be joining BLC in September than at any time in the last eight years and we are very excited that you and your child will be part of our school community next year.

Your child will be joining a school that has improved rapidly and continues to be ambitious for all of its pupils. Our progress was recognised during by OFSTED in their full inspection report of November 2021. They judged our school to be "Good" in all areas, citing
