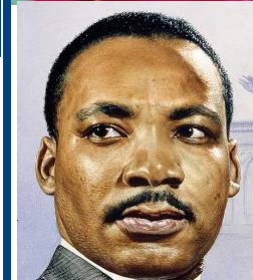

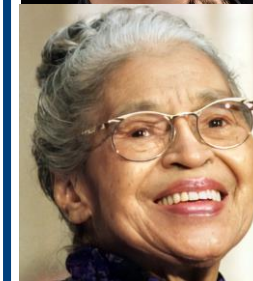
Martin Luther King Jr

Martin Luther King was an African American civil rights activist. He famously made a speech in Washington DC called the "I Have a Dream" speech. He helped change the laws of equality in the USA but was sadly assassinated by a lone gunman in 1968.



Greta Thunberg

Greta Thunberg is a Swedish student and climate change activist who tries to raise awareness about climate change around the world. She has made many speeches to world leaders and famous influential people about the dangers of ignoring our climate.



Rosa Parks

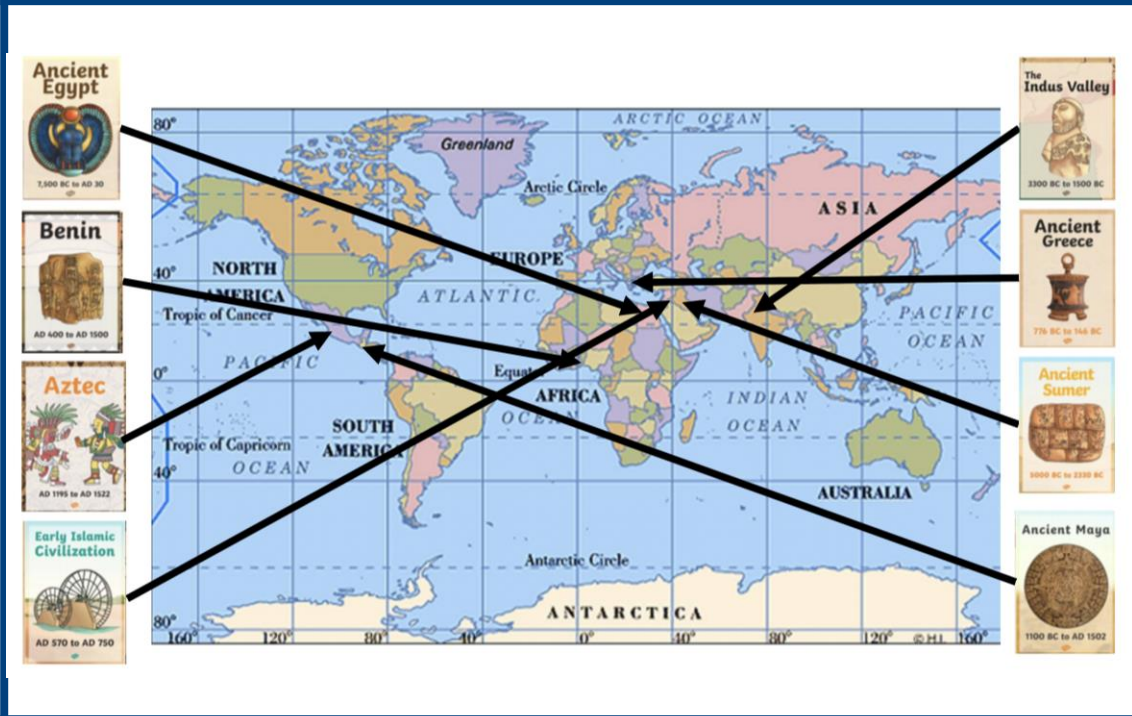
Rosa Parks was a black woman who played an important part in the American civil rights movement. She famously refused to give up her seat to a white person on a bus. She campaigned throughout her lifetime for equality and inclusion in the USA.

Ancient Egyptian beliefs



- The ancient Egyptians had many gods and goddesses. Some gods were stars, others were humans and animals.
- The funerary god, Anubis, is commonly shown in art as a jackal (a dog).
- The gods represented natural forces such as storms, thunder, fire and death.
- Pharaohs were chosen by the gods.
- Temples were filled with images of the gods and only the pharaoh and the priests could go inside.

Ancient Mayan beliefs

- The Maya believed in many gods each representing a different part of life.
- The gods had to be pleased so Maya communities made regular offerings to them in the form of animal (and sometimes human) sacrifices.
- Maya households buried their dead underneath the floors so they could protect the living.
- Itzamna was the creator god. K'inich Ahau was the sun god. The Night Jaguar represented the sun on its journey.
